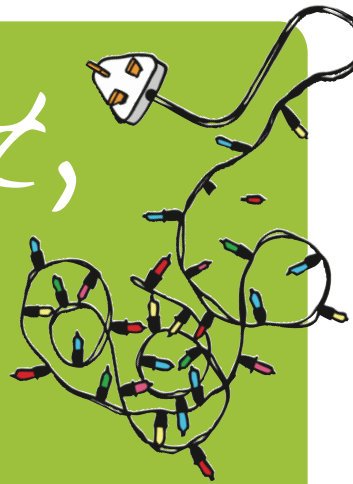

## **Chanctonbury Mobile Recycling Events**

From September 2012 you will be able to bring along your old, broken or unwanted electricals for recycling. So when you find the Christmas lights have lost their sparkle, the toaster is toast or the TV just can't be fixed, help is at hand from your Mobile Recycling Event.

This year we are asking residents to help trial a new scheme for the collection of electrical items, household batteries and low energy lighting. This trial is being run in partnership with Viridor – the site operator, Horsham District Council and West Sussex County Council.

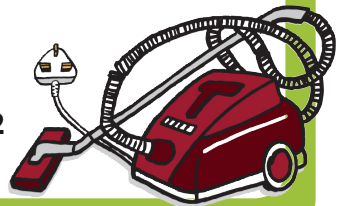

# What electrical items can be recycled in Chanctonbury?

## Electronic Devices

Phones, mobile phones, remote controls, chargers, radios, VCRs, digiboxes, speakers, hi-fi units, electronic toys and more.

## Electrical Personal Care

Hairdryers, hair straighteners, electric toothbrushes, hair trimmers, shavers, hair curlers, facial saunas, power showers and more.

## Electrical Appliances

Kettles, toasters, irons, blenders, sandwich toasters, coffee machines, whisks, bread makers, electric scales, smoothie makers and more.

## DIY & Garden Electricals

Drills, power tools, garden shears, strimmers, jigsaws, sanders, angle grinders, electric chainsaws, electric lawnmowers and more.

## TVs & Monitors

TV and monitors – which includes old style and new flat screen designs and laptops

## Large Items

Washing machines, electric cookers, microwaves, fridges, freezers and tumble dryers

## Light Bulbs & Batteries

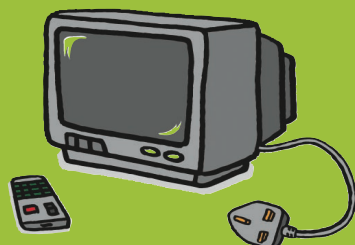
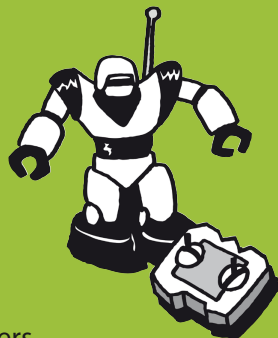
Low energy light bulbs, fluorescent tubes and household batteries
