

FAQs - Liquid Food & Drink Cartons

- **What are liquid food and drink cartons?**

They are paper based cartons made from paperboard, low density polyethylene and aluminium foil. The internal aluminium foil lining is only featured in long life products.

The most recognisable liquid food and drink cartons are known as Tetra Paks.

- **How are cartons recycled?**

During the sorting process at Ford Materials Recycling Facility, the cartons are separated along with mixed paper and are sent to paper mills in either the UK, mainland Europe or other overseas destinations.

- **What are the cartons recycled into?**

Liquid food & drink cartons can be recycled into a wide range of products from plasterboard liner to high strength paper bags and envelopes.
