



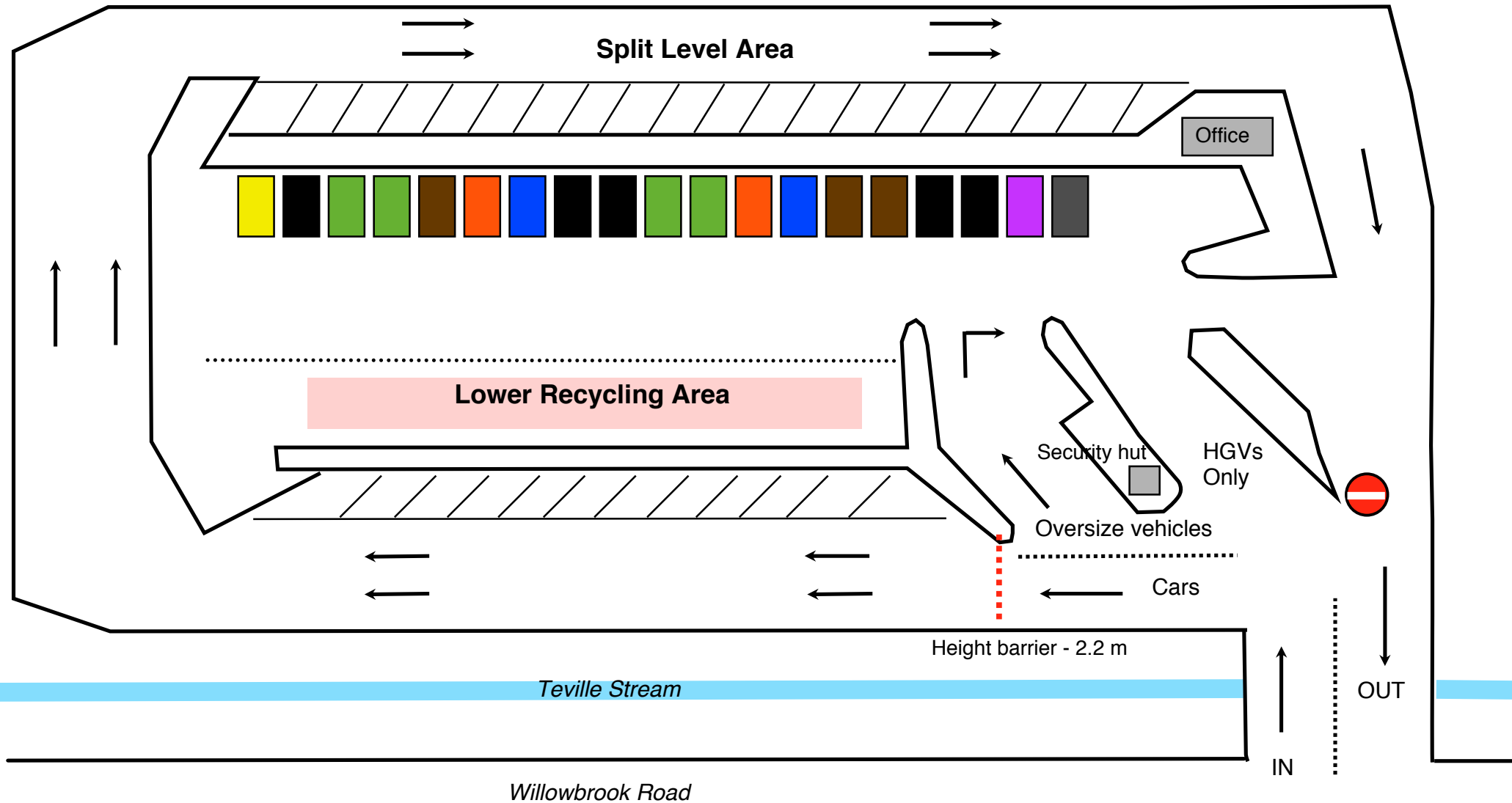

Worthing Household Waste Recycling Site

Reclaim West Sussex is a partnership of all local councils in West Sussex working with Viridor. It is committed to improving waste recycling facilities and is working to achieve a target of 45% of household waste recycled by 2015.

In order to do this Reclaim West Sussex needs to update existing recycling and waste management facilities across the County, as well as providing new ones.

The Household Waste Recycling Site

The site includes a lower area for recycling and storage for cans, plastic / glass bottles, car batteries, household batteries, CDs & DVDs, fridges / freezers, large & small electrical appliances, fluorescent tubes & low energy bulbs, gas bottles, hazardous / flammable waste, textiles, TVs, tyres and waste engine oil.

On the upper level there are separate containers for:

- Household waste, green waste, mixed paper and card, scrap metal, small electrical appliances.
- Plasterboard, wood and soil hardcore - 200kg limit per visit applies.

Please ensure **recyclable** materials are kept separate and any loose waste/ green waste is bagged, into easily manageable loads.

Site restrictions & controls

Worthing site has a separate unloading bay for vehicles over 2.2 metres (7ft 2 inches) which are under the gross vehicle weight of 3 tonnes.

Vehicles over 2.2 metres (7ft 2 inches) will not be allowed into the lower or upper recycling areas. **Height barriers are in place.**

Site security will monitor vehicle movements and the waste being deposited.

Only household waste can and will be accepted on site. It is against the law to deposit any Trade Waste at Household Waste Recycling Sites.

Hours of Operation

The Household Waste Recycling site has been designed to be open seven days a week. However, they will be closed on Christmas Day and Boxing Day.
